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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY + KEY TAKEAWAYS

Market Snapshot (May 20, 2026 Close): US equities posted a strong bullish session with broad participation. The S&P; 500 closed at **7,432.97** (+1.08%), Nasdaq at **26,270.36** (+1.54%), and Russell 2000 led with **+2.56%** at 2,817.36, signaling small-cap outperformance. Dow Jones rose ~1.31% to ~50,009. VIX eased to **17.44** (-3.43%), indicating reduced fear. Commodities saw energy strength (WTI/Brent up ~2%) while gold held elevated levels near \$4,500+/oz. Treasury yields ticked higher (~4.57-4.61% on 10Y). Retail sentiment turned bullish on the gains, with positive flows into tech ETFs.

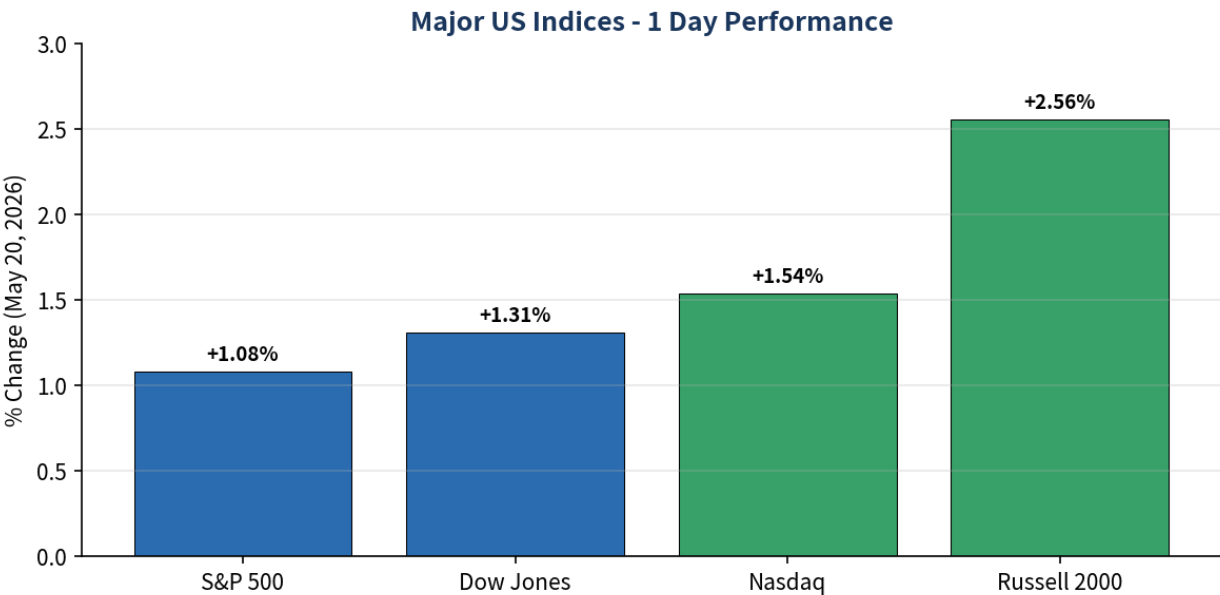

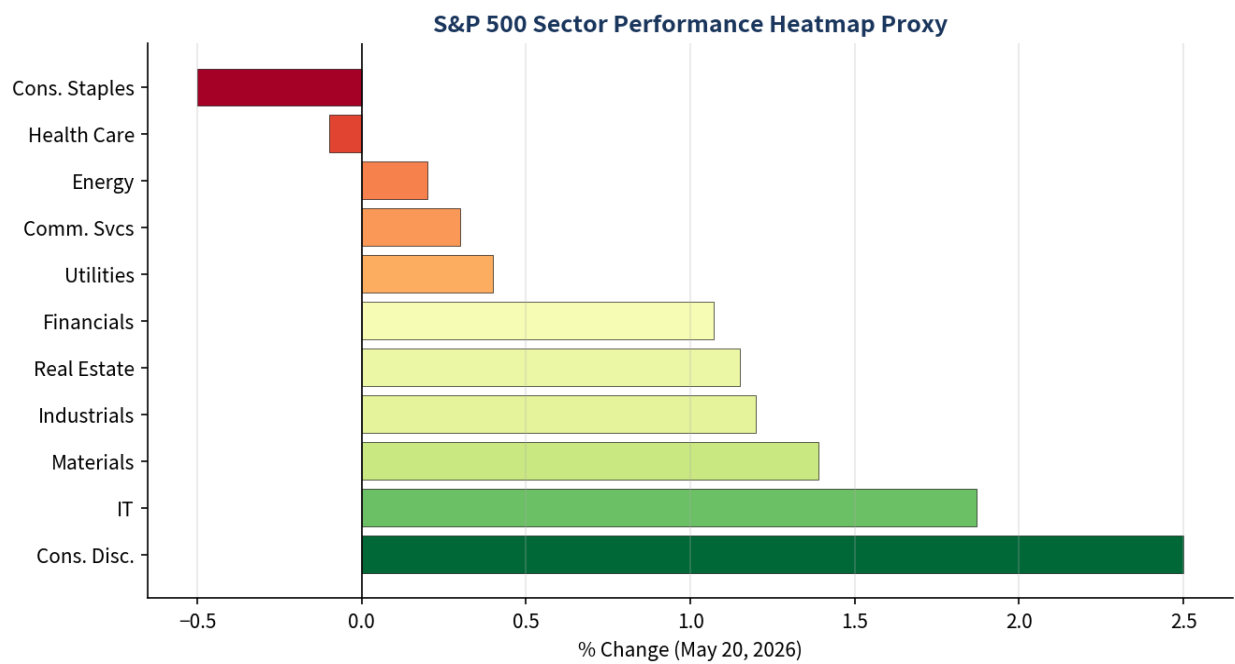

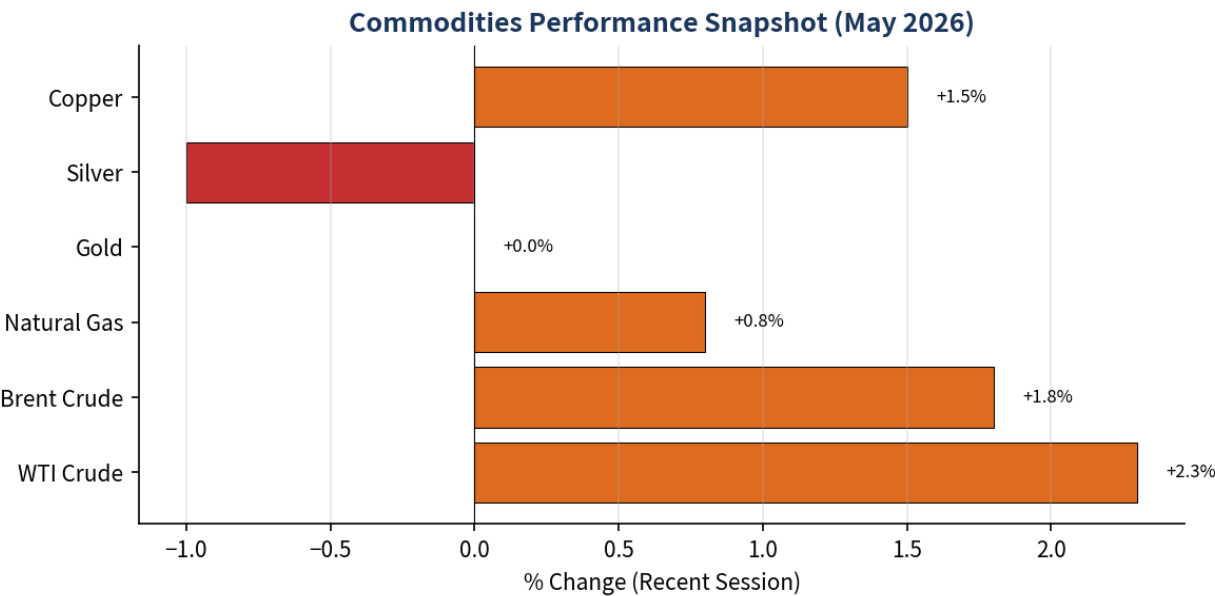

Key Drivers: Oil inventory reports (EIA), geopolitical tensions, demand outlook. COT positioning showed institutional interest in energy.

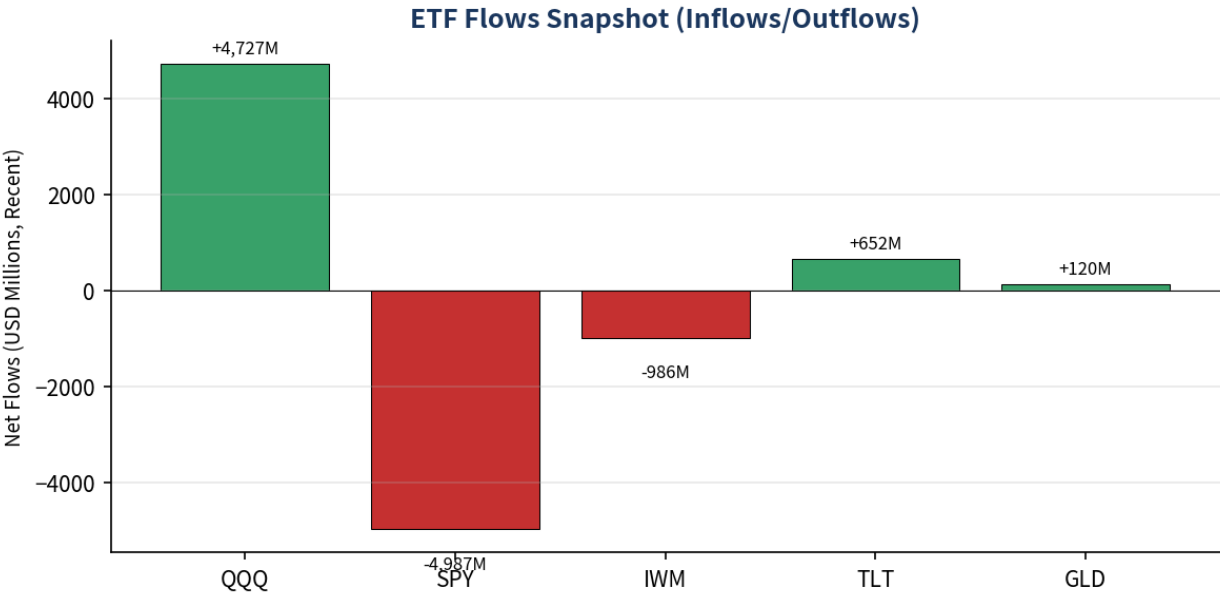

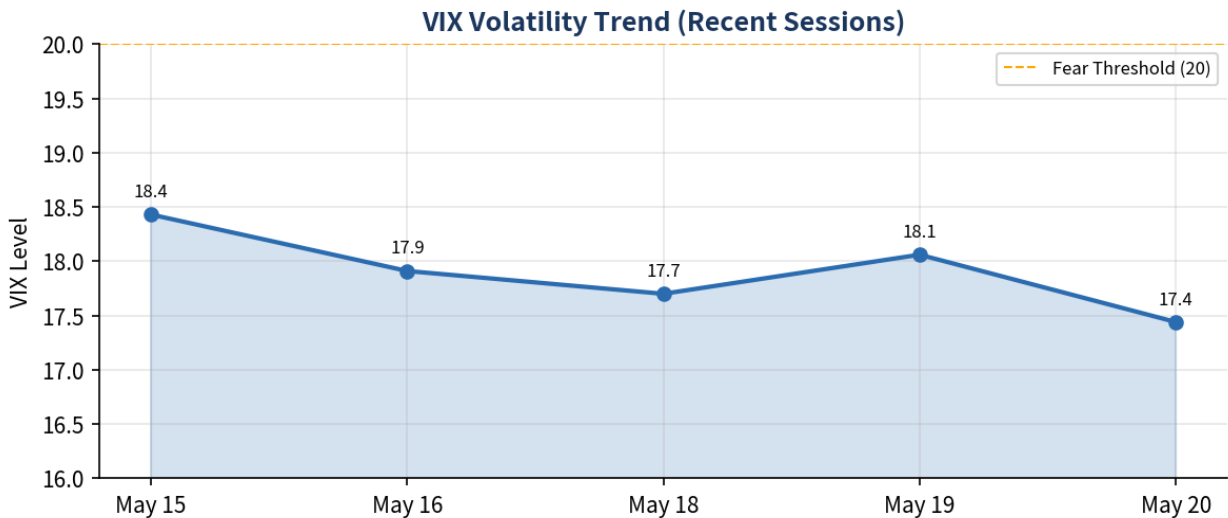

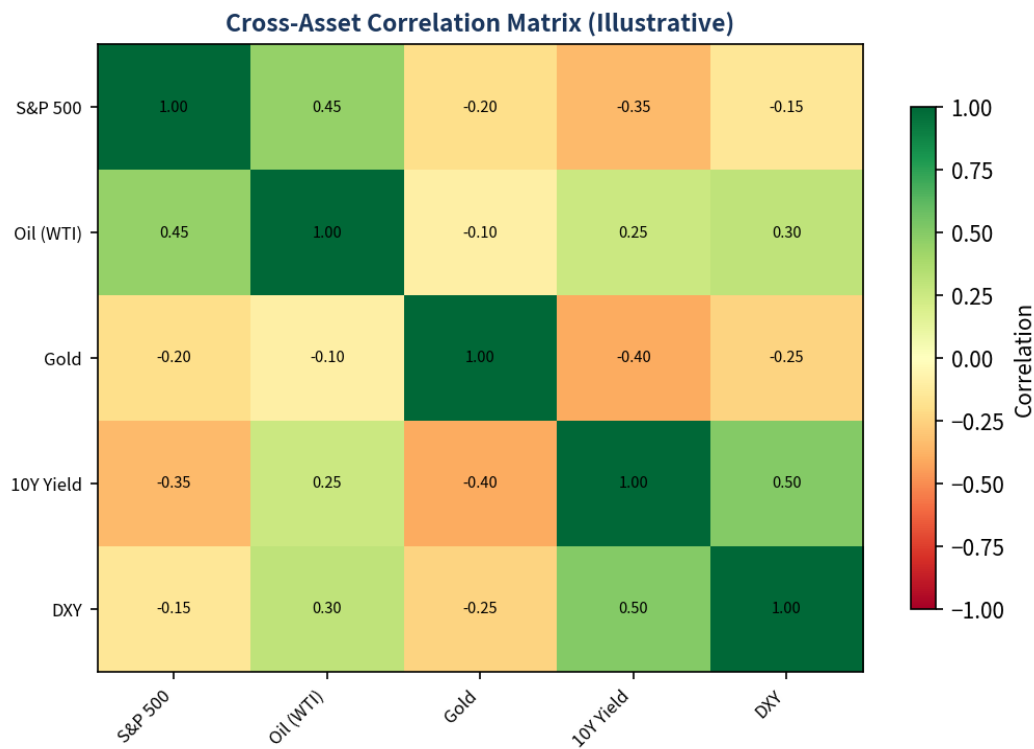
